Discussion and approval of event budget request form. Discussion and approval of a date in December for the celebration with 12/21, 12/19, 12/18 and 12/23 as potential dates. Discussion and approval of event press release.

#### A. Chair Iturri led discussion

Councilmember Reyes, thanked Council for Special Meeting. Requested event be done in December, an Ad hoc be created to guide process.

Chair Iturri called for motion to create an Ad hoc committee.

Councilmember Alcaraz made a Motion to create an Ad Hoc for the Winter Celebration Community Project. Councilmember Allan seconded. Vote. All in favor. Approved.

Councilmembers to be on Ad hoc: Councilmembers Alcaraz & Reyes. Councilmember Allan made a Motion to approve 2 members on Ad hoc. Chair Iturri seconded. Vote. All in favor. Approved.

Chair Iturri called for a motion to approve date/time + set up and clean up.
