The Enforceable Obligation Payment Schedule (EOPS) was originally adopted on 8/23/11 as required by ABx1 26. An Amended EOPS was adopted on 9/27/11 to make corrections and add enforceable obligations that were omitted in error.

This Second Amended EOPS was adopted on 1/31/12 to make additional corrections, to reflect actual expenditures through 12/31/11, and to extend the timeline by 6 months, as necessitated by State Supreme Court action on 12/29/11, which set-back the dates contained in ABx1 26.

This Second Amended EOPS will be submitted to the Successor Agency to be used as the basis for preparation of the draft Recognized Obligation Payments Schedule by 3/1/12.

This Second Amended EOPS will be used as the basis of payments by the Successor Agency until approval of the final ROPS by the Oversight Board.

The payments shown on this schedule for August - December 2011 are actual costs incurred during those months; however, in some cases costs are listed in the month during which they were recorded in the general ledger.

The monthly payments noted on this schedule for January - June 2012 are estimates. The amount to be disbursed in any given month may be higher or lower than the amount shown, not to exceed the aggregate amount shown in the Total column.
