NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
COUNTY OF SONOMA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO RECEIVE AND CONSIDER DRAFT REDISTRICTING MAPS RECOMMENDED BY THE ADVISORY REDISTRICTING COMMISSION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors on November 2, 2021 at 8:45 a.m. to receive and consider draft redistricting maps recommended by the Advisory Redistricting Commission. Every 10 years, local governments use data from the Census to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have changed. Redistricting determines which neighborhoods and communities are grouped together into a district for purposes of electing members to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. Community participation is strongly encouraged to ensure district lines respect neighborhoods, communities of interest, history and geographical elements. The Advisory Redistricting Commission held its final meetings on October 18, 22 and 25 to deliberate on recommended maps for the Board's consideration and has considered all public testimony in its recommendations.

The November 2, 2021 public hearing will be facilitated virtually through Zoom. Members of the public can watch or join the meeting using one of the three following methods:
