Lisa Elliott reports they've had 29 or 30 referrals in total and have continued working with 24 of those clients in various ways, through engagement, while in custody, and continue engagement at different levels when they're released. She reports a couple cases where clients have been appreciative and ready to receive help and support with the services they can provide. Some barriers are that they aren't always aware of when a client is released, resulting in loss of contact. Lisa Lobb says they have room for more referrals. David asks if there is any data on WPC? Lisa agrees that's something they'd like to focus on, but reiterates the barrier of continued care after release without knowing of the | **Desiree adds Sonoma county Whole Person Care could accept referrals while they're still in custody. 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| | <p>release. The majority of these referrals come from Public Defenders, Wellpath, Kaitlyn Dunaway, and the in-jail hospital. David adds this may be a good focus point for the next quarter. David asks were there any trends this last quarter, regarding services, housing, food, SUD, MH..? Lisa replies, food, calfresh, phone, housing (challenge, can we get someone to a shelter quickly?), benefit applications are all things they assist with. MH services pose a challenge due to potential recipients being unwilling to receive these services. David asks if we could focus on data for the quarter to have a better sense of the trends.
